Experience in the treatment of diseases of the female genital area (cases from practice)

A 38-year-old woman presented on November 9, 2006 with complaints of pain in both mammary glands, pain in the lower abdomen, irregularities in the menstrual-ovarian cycle (delayed mensis for 2 weeks). All this began to bother her two months ago.

On ultrasound of the mammary glands - fibrocystic mastopathy; on ultrasound of the pelvic organs - chronic adnexitis and endometrioid cysts of both ovaries.

In the course of diagnostics by the ART method, it was revealed: ovaries D30, mammary glands D15 (both right and left), fibrous mastopathy D6, cystic mastopathy D6, adnexitis D8, endometriosis and chronic cystitis, cystic formations in the ovaries. All these processes are associated with dysfunction of the thyroid gland (severe endocrine disorders) and infections of the genitourinary tract (Trichomonas, ureaplasma, chlamydia).

For the treatment were selected homeopathic preparations of the company "ONOM" (DRE, DIS, RIGE), "Imedis" (antibacterial), resonance-frequency therapy was used to destroy pathogens, BRT to correct the functioning of the thyroid gland and ovaries. OBR and PBS drugs were created through organopreparations of the ovaries, mammary glands, thyroid gland, as well as through the nosodes "adnexitis", "fibrous mastopathy", "cystic mastopathy", "endometriosis" and through the chain "ovaries + cystic formations". The patient received resonance-frequency therapy and BRT on equipment and for a long time, recorded on crumbs. Hirudotherapy was used as an additional method of treatment (7 sessions). The spouse was examined and treated for genitourinary infections.

Pains in the mammary glands disappeared quite quickly (during the first week of treatment), pains in the lower abdomen disappeared by the end of the second week, and the cycle returned to normal.

Repeated ultrasound of the pelvic organs on February 16, 2007 showed no signs of inflammation and endometriosis. There are no cysts.
