Case from practice Petrov Yu.G.

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Patient Oksana L., 25 years old. I went to the Center with a complaint of prolonged (up to 3 weeks) bleeding after mensis. Anamnesis: cystitis, adnexitis, for which she underwent a course of therapy in a hospital. Previously, there was an abortion.

After computer diagnostics by the method of vegetative resonance test (ART) "IMEDIS-TEST" revealed: Trichomonas infection, thrush cystitis, endometriosis, as well as infection with the hepatitis virus nia – ni B in potency D6, which indicated the multicomponent nature of the cause of this pathology.

A course of electropunctural and bioresonance therapy was carried out, directed against the corresponding infectious pathologies, in combination with local anti-inflammatory therapy and hemostatic therapy with dicinone. At the same time, drainage homeopathic remedies were given.

It was possible to stop the pathological symptoms during the first 2-week course of treatment. At the same time, the spouse was being treated.

This and similar cases of an integrated show the effectiveness of approach in the treatment of acute polysyndromic infectious diseases nature, when the combination multiresonance therapy, homeopathy and allopathy shortens the treatment time and increases the stability of the treatment result.

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
