Treatment of blood diseases from the standpoint of bioresonance therapy
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Today, one of the most pressing problems of official medicine is the treatment of blood diseases. It is known that the successful therapy of patients with this pathology is very problematic. However, experience shows that bioresonance and multiresonance therapy is an alternative option that allows you to get good results in the treatment of patients with this pathology.

Some observations on this problem are offered to your attention.

Multiresonance therapy was performed in a group of 45 patients. The nosological forms were distributed as follows: acute leukemia - 1 patient, thrombocytopenic purpura - 4, myelodysplastic syndrome - 2, iron deficiency anemia - 38 cases.

The treatment was carried out at the APK "IMEDIS-EXPERT". Bioresonance therapy, homeopathic remedies recorded on crumbs from an electronic selector, induction therapy, resonance frequency therapy, and fixed frequency therapy were used. In the case of acute leukemia, biologically active additives from Vision were prescribed in parallel, which were strictly selected by testing.

I will briefly dwell on the main points of therapy:

- 1. At the beginning of the treatment, the diagnosis and removal of geopathogenic, radioactive and electromagnetic loads, which were observed in 89% of patients.
- 2. In all patients, i.e. in 100% of cases, a pointer to congenital intoxication (Intox III), which we regarded as an indication of induced interference fields. This problem was solved using chronosemantic therapy.
- 3. The next step was the correction of amino acids, allowing almost the next day to get an improvement in the picture of peripheral blood. (Amino acid correction technique will be discussed in detail at the seminar). Bone marrow normalization was, of course, much slower.
- 4. Next, the blockade from chromosomes and an indication of genetic flaws were removed with the help of chronosemantic therapy.
- 5. After removal of congenital intoxication, correction of amino acids and restoration of chromosomes, a general bioresonance preparation was recorded. According to observations, most often "triggered" meridians of blood circulation, spleen / pancreas, endocrine, bladder, although it must be remembered that the choice of meridians was strictly individual.
- 6. In the case of acute leukemia, a BR-drug was added to the treatment, recorded in the frequencies of the blood circulation meridian from the sternum area, and BRpreperat recorded in the frequencies of the spleen / pancreas meridian from the spleen area. The preparations were recorded as follows:

bioresonance therapy along the selected meridian with frequency modulation at fixed frequencies, selected through disharmonic oscillations. Various homeopathic remedies were added to the contour, also selected through disharmonic vibrations, and a health matrix was always added. The drug was recorded during the last 3 minutes of treatment.

- 7. It should be noted that parasitic burden was tested only in patients with iron deficiency anemia. Resonance-frequency therapy was carried out with the additional appointment of adsorbents: modifilan, chitosan, polysorbovit.
- 8. All patients were prescribed homeopathic complex preparations, matched to the meridians, which were determined through the optimal reserves of adaptation.

The treatment results were distributed as follows:

- a) iron deficiency anemia a quick and fairly stable recovery; thrombocytopenic purpura two patients were in remission for 2 years (to date), 2 other patients had relapses of the disease one year after the end of treatment, associated with the appearance of Intox III. After chronosemantic therapy stable normalization of the peripheral blood picture the next day;
 - b) a patient with acute leukemia has a remission of 4 years (up to the present time); c) myelodysplastic syndrome improvement, currently these patients are being treated.

Conclusions: multiresonance therapy is a highly effective method of treating such a formidable pathology as blood diseases.
