

New aspects in the treatment of endocrine pathology
by the method of bioresonance therapy

Endocrine pathology includes a large group of diseases associated with disorders of hormonal regulation of the body at various levels.

This work does not claim to be a comprehensive consideration of this problem. She offers some ways to regulate hormonal levels, allowing you to get good results.

The therapy was carried out at the APK "IMEDIS-EXPERT". The following treatment regimen is offered to your attention:

1. At the beginning of therapy, as with any other pathology, we test and we remove geopathogenic, radioactive and electromagnetic loads.

2. At the second stage, we test the presence of induced interference fields and remove them using chronosemantic therapy.

3. Next, we carry out the correction of amino acids.

We apply the above measures at any other pathology.

4. At endocrine pathology particular a place occupy psycho-emotional problems the patient, therefore it is imperative conducting induction therapy before recording a BR-drug. To do this, we write off disharmonic vibrations from the head area in a fast mode along all meridians and, using them as a pointer, select an induction program. This can be any program not necessarily related to endocrine regulation. We carry out induction therapy in the form of bioresonance therapy on the head area along the meridians of blood circulation, endocrine, gallbladder, bladder with frequency modulation by the selected induction program. Sometimes we add complex homeopathic remedies to the circuit.

5. After induction therapy, we look at the connection of the endocrine meridian with chromosomes. Most often, the X chromosome in women and the Y chromosome in men are "triggered". Using the identified chromosomes as a pointer, we carry out chronosemantic therapy. The drug, recorded from the chronosemantic line, is always given once.

6. Next, it is important to determine which point or points on other meridians cause dysregulation of the endocrine meridian. To do this, we place inductors on the patient: a "loop" on the head, 2 belts: one - in front, the other - behind; hands are on the plates. We write off the disharmonic oscillations in the frequencies of the endocrine meridian and, using them as an indicator, we find the drug in the group "electronic spectra of points". Most often, one point is determined, we use it in addition when recording a BR-preparation.

When recording BR drugs, we always add a health matrix to the contour. The resulting drug is prescribed in an increasing dosage.

Example

Patient V., 27 years old. Secondary amenorrhea within 7 years after abortion. An attempt to use hormone therapy caused a sharp increase in weight, in connection with which the patient refused it. On ultrasound of the pelvic organs, the uterus is unremarkable, the size of the ovaries is the lower limit of the norm, single follicles.

On initial testing: congenital intoxication (Intox III), false polarity, viral burden; photon indices anterior pituitary gland - 19, thyroid gland - 16, ovaries - 17, pelvic and uterovaginal plexuses - 19, herpes simplex 2, cytomegalovirus are tested on these plexuses; thymus - 16; tumors and cysts are not defined anywhere.

The treatment was carried out according to the above-described method. Additionally, homeopathic and BR medications were prescribed to correct the thymus. Virus elimination was carried out according to the method described by S.L. Sobotovich. in an article from this collection.

As a result of 5 months of treatment, photon indices in the range of 7-9 units, the normal menstrual cycle was restored, further treatment is planned to correct the weight.
