

## Clinical Cases

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I never cease to be amazed at how everything is thought out, how many secret paths in medicine, how everything is logical and interconnected when diagnosing by the method of autonomic resonance test (ART).

I bring to your attention an analysis of several case histories.

1. Patient D., 51 years old. Complaints about a persistent runny nose since childhood.

Removed

tonsils, polyp of the vocal cords - without a noticeable improvement in health. When diagnosed by the ART method - a chronic degenerative process in the mucous membranes of the large intestine. Revealed hepatitis A virus, pseudo-rotten clostridium, worms (worms) in the rectum and giardia lamblia in the mucous membrane of the large intestine. The case is typical and the therapy that was carried out gave a good result. But surprisingly, the most effective drug was Blatt Orientales - a black cockroach. In her youth, the woman lived in a hostel where the main residents were black cockroaches. The products of their vital activity and the infection with the infections they carry were the main background against which the chronic degenerative process developed.

2. The well-known gonorrhoea, which is well treated by venereologists, turns out to be very insidious and not always diagnosed. A respectable family of 4 people. A 43-year-old father, a food worker, complains of frequent urination at night. When diagnosed by the ART method - gonorrhoea of the internal genital organs, sacral vertebrae, rectum and sacral plexus, latent, has not been previously diagnosed by anyone. My son is 17 years old, disabled person II gr. revealed gonorrhoeal miasm, congenital cytomegalovirus with damage to the brain and gastrointestinal tract. The boy has been disabled since childhood due to epilepsy, cerebral hypertension, mental retardation. None of the infections have been clarified by orthodox medicine. And such disabled people only passed through our office 3 people in just 2 years, and how many are there in the country?

3. Another example from the "gonorrhoea" series. Young woman, 24 years old. From 23 years old disabled person II gr. for spinal cord injury (etiology not known) - progressive lumbago with severe non-relieving pain syndrome. Equine foot on the right. She underwent orthodox inpatient treatment with no effect. When diagnosed by the ART method, gonorrhoeal miasm was revealed. Treatment - BRT, homeopathy, drains - gave an excellent effect. The pain in the spine disappeared. Her 5-year-old daughter also had gonorrhoeal miasm. The girl is hyperexcitable, often ill, until gross developmental abnormalities are noted.

4. A rare case. Female doctor, 52 years old. Suffers from strong headaches pain. The pain is relieved by wearing a biocorrector with which she does not part. During the diagnosis by the ART method, Pseudomonas aeruginosa was found in the spinal cord, hepatica fasciola, Mansonia schistosoma, and asperillus niger. After BRT, EPT, and small pustules begin to appear on the skin, which

burst easily and painlessly. Some small black dots are visible inside. I remove them and take them to the microbiology laboratory. Conclusion: red tick.

Son of 23 years old, disabled since childhood. Appealed for post-traumatic encephalopathy. A sickly young man. When treating the identified diseases of the son, a similar situation is observed - small pustules, and a red tick was also identified. It turned out that they ate spikelets of wheat collected in the field during the time of famine.

So, evaluating the results of diagnostics, you understand that everything that was considered casuistry in conventional medicine becomes commonplace when using the vegetative resonance test.

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
