

Treatment of chronic nonspecific infectious prostatitis on
equipment "IMEDIS"

As you know, a disease such as chronic prostatitis is a very serious problem, both personal and social. According to official statistics, 60–70% of the adult male population suffers from chronic prostatitis. Various sexual dysfunctions, infertility as a result of chronic prostatitis, debilitating pain syndrome leave a negative psycho-emotional imprint on the patient, create difficulties in family relationships and in the labor sphere.

The biggest problem with chronic prostatitis is treatment. For a long time, this disease has retained the status of "incurable", and all treatment consisted in stopping exacerbations of the inflammatory process throughout the patient's subsequent life.

LLC "Center for Energy Information Medicine" (Samara) about five deals with ^{years old} the problems of diagnosis and treatment of chronic nonspecific inflammatory diseases of the male and female genital area, correction of sexual dysfunctions. In the process of work, a certain tactic was formed in the diagnosis and treatment of chronic prostatitis. According to our data, in 94% of patients with chronic prostatitis, the following pathogens are detected in the urethra and prostate gland using the ART method: chlamidia trachomatis, ureaplasma urealiticum, mycoplasma genitalium, mycoplasma hominis, trichomonas vaginalis, both monoinfections and in the form of mixed associations. Prostatitis caused by these pathogens is characterized by a primary chronic and malosymptomatic course, although significant changes in the structure of the prostate gland are found in the diagnosis by the method of R. Voll and ART and ultrasound examination. With this prostatitis, it suffers, first of all, copulatory and reproductive functions. Also characteristic for these types of urogenital infections is the absence of a local cellular immune response, which causes scant clinical symptoms.

Case from practice

Patient I., 48 years old. I turned to "TSEIM" on June 17, 2004 with complaints of a burning sensation in the urethra and in the perineal region, cramps during urination, frequent urination and weakening of the urine stream pressure. Irritability, nervousness, insomnia appeared.

According to the patient, the diagnosis of chronic prostatitis was first made two years ago, when cramps first appeared during urination.

According to ultrasound data: the prostate gland is enlarged in size, the contours are even, the echo structure is heterogeneous, in the transition zones there is an area of increased echogenicity, in the central zone there is a hyperechoic inclusion with a diameter of up to 10 mm with a powerful shadow.

Diagnostics using the ART method determines: electromagnetic, radioactive, psychovegetative and toxic loads; chronic colitis, chronic prostatitis, epididymitis, candidiasis, stones are tested

prostate. There are bacterial, viral and fungal burdens.

Treatment tactics:

1. The course of treatment with BRT (general and specific BR-drugs, selected through the optimal step for adaptation reserves, organopreparations).

2. Treatment with nosodes in conjunction with drainage homeopathic preparations of the ONOM company.

3. Course fixed frequencies (anti-fungal, antibacterial, antiviral, symptomatic).

4. Removal of psycho-vegetative loads and neuroendocrine disorders (preparations "GUNA", Bach Flowers, programs of the brain rhythm).

As a result of treatment on 12.10.2004: the patient's general condition improved, cramps, burning sensations, sexual dysfunctions disappeared, sleep returned to normal, "joy in life" appeared.

According to the last ultrasound: the prostate gland is of normal size, in the central zone there is a hyperechoic inclusion with a diameter of up to 4–5 mm.

Thus, the methods of treatment on the "IMEDIS" equipment should be more widely introduced into the practice of treating chronic prostatitis and various kinds of sexual disorders of both male and female genital spheres.
