

Case from practice

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Patient K. complained of skin rashes in the form of red spots, which were accompanied by itching, aggravated after water procedures. Over the past two weeks, the number of spots has increased, as well as pain in the left hypochondrium and chills. These symptoms appeared a few days after the patient (a doctor by profession) injured his finger during medical manipulation of the patient. Later it turned out that the patient who underwent the manipulation was admitted to the hospital with a diagnosis of "Newly diagnosed diabetes mellitus" after a viral infection.

When examining a patient using the Voll method, there is a decrease in indicators at the points of the meridian of the pancreas and spleen, meridian of the endocrine system up to 30 conv. units The nosode of the Coxsackie B6 virus is being tested at the aforementioned points and points of the allergy meridian.

Therapy was carried out with homeopathic preparations Coccylus D6, Senna D6, Silicea D12, Phosphor D6 and the nosode of the Coxsackie virus B6 D12.

Within two weeks, almost all symptoms were stopped: the skin cleared, pains in the left hypochondrium and chills stopped, and the symptoms did not recur. Biochemical blood test is normal (before the start of therapy, alkaline phosphatase and total bilirubin were increased).

This case shows the high efficiency of the combination of drainage homeopathic medicines with nosode therapy for infectious diseases. at correct etiological diagnostics and corresponding pathogenetic therapy even without the use of antibacterial and symptomatic drugs.

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
