Why do we need a Christmas tree in the new year?

During the winter period of time, more precisely, from mid-December to mid-January, the Earth is located at the point farthest from the Sun. At this time, the speed of its rotation slightly slows down, which leads to changes in gravitational-magnetic states that affect all earthly material objects, and, first of all, biological objects, including humans.

As a means of protection against such changes in many people during this period, sensory perception is quite sharply exacerbated, and it is not without reason that the most mysterious and intimate fortune-telling fell on winter time.

It was then that the Christmas tree turned up under the arm, the shape, the size, the color of which is just perfect for the embodiment of the wishes.

By its structure, the tree is a fibrous tree with a resinous base, and, being in the magnetic field of the Earth, is, of course, a kind of source of radiation.

The orientation of the tree as a parabolic antenna directed vertically upward is enhanced by the number of levels of radii of the branches and their fluffiness.

By placing the tree in the center of the living room (and preferably in the center of the room) a few days before Christmas, i.e. at the very peak of the Earth's distance from the Sun in winter), we do not immediately dress it up, since at first it should act as an elementary energy diffuser and slightly dynamize the space of future work, in other words, prepare the energy of the room.

The second rule: the higher the level of placement of a desire on a tree, the more delicate the intangible effect in order to fulfill it, therefore it is recommended to place direct, basic desires on the lower branches along the outer contour, and hide the most intimate secrets in the thick of the needles, closer to the trunk.

The tree itself should stand in water or in wet ground, but not have direct contact with the Ground (parquet, flooring).

The top (or simply the crown) should not be left unadorned and must be completed with a sharp end (star or traditional tip), and it is from the top that tinsel should begin

Tinsel is an additional reinforcement, a top-down direction, which, if incorrectly placed, can seriously damage the entire circuit.

Light bulbs (candles) are highly desirable as their light acts as a photonic amplifier for the antenna.

To harmonize the rather potent aroma of natural resinous needles, it is advisable to simultaneously introduce, for example, the smell of citrus fruits, which will additionally create a good complex sanitizing effect in order to prevent colds, which in themselves are already quite frequent in winter, but given the heightened sensory perception it is on these days, superimposed on the pre-holiday bustle and chores, the risk of getting sick slightly increases.

The final appearance of the decorated Christmas tree will also have a general stimulating effect on the body weakened in winter - shiny, sparkling, exciting, that is, invigorating and evoking positive emotions.

And after the Christmas tree is decorated and the atmosphere is prepared, it is necessary for all household members to join hands and in a good mood and with traditional benevolent songs in anticipation of the coming of the holiday, receiving gifts and fulfilling desires, go around the tree counterclockwise in a round dance, preferably several times.

Gifts should be sure to spend the night the night before under the tree and so the most nourish with positive emotions embedded in them on the pre-holiday night, the effect of sending desires, which will reach its maximum at the moment of the full moon, when the gravitational field of the moon additionally pulls up the drop-shaped electromagnetic field of the Earth, and with it your wishes.

The "wishmaker" Christmas tree at home harmonizes not only the space around itself, but the whole house, therefore, on the eve of the holiday, keep the doors open for unhindered entry

positive energies to all its corners. However, when everyday life begins and ordinary everyday problems, disputes, and unnecessary conversations return, it is better to disassemble the tree or try to close the room where it stands and protect the natural repeater from unnecessary negative emotions.

After the holidays, it is advisable not to just take the tree out into the street as ordinary garbage, but, for example, to dynamize it with high-temperature exposure, that is, simply burn it, and thus solve the problem of an accidental negative impact on your innermost wishes from other persons or natural phenomena.

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
