The results of research to identify persons who use drugs from among the military in the Federal State Institution 1458 of Mozdok

As a method of preliminary diagnostics, the vegetative resonance test (ART) is recommended for use in military command and control bodies, formations and military units of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, other ministries and departments where military service is provided for by law.

According to the orders of the GVMU, the military hospital of the city of Mozdok continues to work on identifying people who use drugs and toxic substances, the statute of limitations and the frequency of their admission.

Purpose of the work: on the basis of the study, to show the value of the hardware-software complex (APC) "IMEDIS-EXPERT" in the screening examination of military personnel for the fact of using narcotic and toxic substances.

Materials and methods: to solve the problem, conscripts and contract servicemen were examined with suspicion of the fact of using narcotic and toxic substances. The age of servicemen ranged from 19 to 34 years, of which 14 (100%) were contract servicemen and 10 (100%) were conscripts. Of these, 1 (4.16%) servicemen under contract and 3 (12.5%) conscripts confirmed the fact of using narcotic and toxic substances. The positive results obtained were further confirmed

immunochromatographic method "Immuno-Chromium 5 Multi-Express". We have studied and evaluated the facts of the positive results of the study of the use of narcotic and toxic substances by conscripts and contract servicemen using the APK "IMEDIS-EXPERT".

Conclusions: the hardware-software complex "IMEDIS-EXPERT", recommended for the study of military personnel on the fact of the use of narcotic and toxic substances, is highly specific and informative.
