Case from practice M.G. Skoroumova (LLC "Center for Energy Information Medicine", Samara, Russia)

Patient V., 11 years old, turned to CEIM on 29.11.06 with complaints of complete loss of eyelashes and eyebrows. Eyebrows fell out at the age of 4 years. Examined and treated by a dermatologist, gastroenterologist - no effect. About a month ago, there was a complete loss of eyelashes at once. On examination, there is no facial hair (eyebrows, eyelashes), the skin around the eyes is unchanged, the physique is asthenic. An examination was carried out using the method of vegetative resonance test (ART), as a result of which it was revealed:

- electromagnetic burden of the 1st degree, affecting the bladder;

- the depleting reserves of adaptation of the 1st degree;
- depletion of the endocrine system 2 tbsp., Affecting the state of the adrenal glands;
- mental stress of the 3rd degree;
- a very strong degree of vegetative burden;
- a moderate degree of depletion of the immune system;
- intestinal dysbiosis;
- burdening with molds (including trichophyton rubrum), bacterial and parasitic burden;
- an indication of the lack of trace elements, enzymes;
- the presence of chronic foci of infection (palatine tonsils), dysfunction of the cervical spine.

Therapy:

1. A course of treatment with BRT (general and specific BR-drugs, selected through the optimal step along the RA).

2. The course of resonance frequency therapy (antifungal, antibacterial, anthelmintic, induction).

3. Treatment with drainage homeopathic preparations ("OHOM", FM-complexes).

4. Nosodotherapy.

- 5. Seroimmunes.
- 6. Diet therapy.
- 7. Probiotic therapy.

8. Selected vitamin and mineral complex.

As a result of the treatment, the hair was completely restored,

hair loss was within normal limits.
