## Case from practice M.G. Elcheva (LLC "Center for Energy Information Medicine, Samara, Russia)

Patient, Osit L.V., 52 years old. In May 2007, she turned to CEIM with complaints of general weakness, loss of strength, drowsiness, loss of appetite, recurrent pain in the left and right hypochondria, bitterness in the mouth and nausea in the morning, flatulence, constipation for five years, overweight. Anamnesis: tonsillectomy, chronic pyelonephritis, mastopathy, in 2004 operated on for Cancer colon, disability II gr.

Ultrasound 2006: chr. cholecystitis, pancreatitis, fatty hepatosis, chr. pyelonephritis.

During the examination by the ART method on the "IMEDIS" equipment, the geopathogenic load, a strong degree of depletion of the immune system, the microbial-parasitic load, burdening the pancreas, were determined, gallbladder burdening with mold fungi, dysbiosis of the small and large intestines.

Prescribed a course of hirudotherapy, sessions of bioresonance therapy, drains of the "ONOM" company, BR-drugs, enterosorbents, antiparasitic treatment, a course of cleansing enemas, a diet was selected, tubazh three times, probiotics.

During the course of treatment, the patient began to notice an improvement in well-being and a regression of symptoms. At the first control examination by ART using IMEDIS equipment: mild depletion of the immune system, absence of geopathogenic load, reduction of microbial and parasitic load on the pancreas, gall bladder, dysbiosis of the small and large intestines caused by the fungus of the genus Candida cruzei. Later, for 4 months, the patient was followed up and received treatment. As a result, the indicators of all digestive organs have improved, pains in the left and right hypochondrium have ceased to bother, there is no bloating, regular bowel movements,

state of health returned to normal, increased vitality, weight decreased by 15 kg (with an increase of 157 cm, weight became 71 kg). At the beginning of 2008, she was transferred from the II disability group to the III group. Observed at CEIM once every three months.
