Equipment of the firm "IMEDIS" in the complex conduct of lymphotropic therapy and pharmacopuncture T.V. Salnikova (Moscow, Russia)

Over the past decades, interest has increased in the problems of lymphology, namely lymphotropic administration of drugs, in which drugs are delivered directly to the lesion focus, and thus long-acting high concentrations of them in the blood and other human tissues are created.

It is extremely important that this method of drug administration enhances their therapeutic effect by stimulating their own defenses.

the patient's body, in particular the immune system, key enzymes lymphocytes, etc.

However, for efficiency use medical properties of the lymphatic system, it is necessary to know the most advantageous places of administration and transport of the drug, methods of administration of drugs, the frequency of administration procedures, dosage and consistency of recipes for mixtures of drugs, adapting the procedure for the treatment of a particular patient.

Next, it is necessary to monitor the effectiveness of the patient's treatment for this method, to monitor the course of the pathological to determine process, individually the number of administration procedures medicines, their consistency and the ratio of drugs with each administration.

We can determine all these parameters of drug administration and control the effectiveness for each patient individually, using a certain method of work on the hardware-software complex "IMEDIS-EXPERT", namely: ART "IMEDIS-TEST".

1. On the basis of "testing of medicines", we determine through Magnum met D26 - drug tolerance; Ferum met. D26 - drug effectiveness; as well as the consistency of the drugs included in the patient's prescription.

2. Then via Cuprum met. D26 we select a specific dose of medication and their ratio in the prescription for a given patient.

3. Through VV we determine the frequency of drug administration.

4. On the meridian system we find the affected meridians.

5. We note which of the meridians are in deficiency, and which are redundant.

6. Through the frequency characteristics of the points of the meridians, we find blocked points along the insufficient meridian and excess points along the excess meridian are the points of pharmacopuncture, taking into account the lymph flow in this area, we determine the direction of needle insertion. It is also taken into account which system - yang or yin - the meridian belongs to and its direction centrifugal or centripetal.

7. It also matters which system the administered drugs belong to, if the Yin meridian is blocked, and we inject the Yang drug, then in this way we slow down the flow of energy along the meridian, if we inject the Yin drug along the Yin meridian, then we increase the energetic activity of this meridian.

It is necessary to take into account the course of the lymphatic vessels when administering drugs,

they are usually combined with the human meridian system.

We can introduce a mixture of drugs, by the type of indirect lymphotropic therapy (S.Yu. Dzhumaev et al., 1969-1987), not only in the places of dislocation of lymphatic vessels and nodes, but also along the meridians, having found by the test (see. above.) locked points. At the same time, if necessary, we can additionally stimulate the energy flow along the meridian or partially block it, which is sometimes necessary in oncological processes, by pharmacopuncture + acupuncture, when several needles (preferably silver) are placed around the needle after the injection of the drug in a circle and additionally left they are for some time up to 30 minutes, then slowly removed; on the contrary, to stimulate (inflow) energy to the point, after pharmacopuncture, placed around the needle (preferably gold), are mechanically irritated within 5–7 minutes. and are quickly retrieved.

The effectiveness of lymphotropic pharmacopuncture procedures can be determined by several parameters of ART "IMEDIS-TEST", primarily by the biological and photon index, by the body's reserves, by the state of the immune and endocrine (if hormonal substances were introduced) systems, by the presence or absence microorganisms (if antibiotics were administered), etc., more often this is associated with a specific problem of the patient.

But in any case, the equipment of the IMEDIS Center is a reliable assistant to the doctor in treating patients with this method of introducing drugs into the body.

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
