

Improving the effectiveness of an electronic preparation
by "zeroing" the original homeopathic grits

Process cooking drug by rewriting the original a homeopathic or allopathic medicine in an electronic selector device "IMEDIS-EXPERT" which must be prevented. Recommendations include selection problems the absence of a number of factors in the workplace that can affect both the patient and the preparation of the electronic preparation in the overwrite mode. These are geopathogenic, radioactive and electromagnetic loads.

The issue is more difficult with the original homeopathic "empty" grits, which are produced at a number of factories in Russia and abroad and supplied to the consumer through a number of intermediary organizations. Long-term testing of the original homeopathic grits, according to the principle factor, showed that both the original acquired homeopathic grits and after storage in a number of arbitrary places after acquisition may have already recorded signals that are undesirable for patients (hepatogenic, radioactive, electromagnetic).

To eliminate the above signals, we have developed a technique for cleaning, erasing or "zeroing" the original homeopathic grits immediately before recording "directly" from the selector (drug directly or in inversion) or from the 2nd container of the apparatus. For this, the original "empty" homeopathic grits in the cup are placed in the 3rd - inverse container of the apparatus.

In the case when an inverse preparation is prepared with a preliminary recording on "clean" crumbs (for example, according to the 4th strategy), unwanted signals are automatically erased in the inversion mode when recording the final preparation. Thus, working on the 4th strategy, or any other that uses the inversion of the original homeopathic grits, gives a more effective result, which has been confirmed by many published works.
