

Information about the test results of the military personnel of the agro-industrial complex "IMEDIS-EXPERT" in the hospital for 2009–2011.

Vegetative resonance test (ART), as a method of preliminary diagnostics, is recommended for use in military command and control bodies, formations and military units of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, other ministries and departments where military service is provided for by law,

Purpose of the work: on the basis of the study, to show the value of the APC (hardware-software complex) "IMEDIS-ESPRT" in the examination of military personnel to identify the use of narcotic and toxic substances.

Materials and methods: to solve problems, conscripts and contract servicemen with suspicion of using narcotic and toxic substances were examined: a total of 66 (100%) people. Of these: 29 (44%) are contract servicemen and 37 (56%) upon appeal.

From the results obtained, it follows that contract servicemen gave 4.5% of positive results, while conscripts, respectively, 24.6%.

The positive results obtained were further confirmed immunochromatographic method "Immuno-Chromium". We have studied and evaluated the positive results of studies on the use of narcotic and toxic substances by conscript and contract servicemen.

Conclusions: hardware-software complex "IMEDIS-EXPERT" recommended for surveys military personnel on the fact use narcotic and toxic substances is highly specific, informative.
