

Experience in the use of bioresonance therapy and complex homeopathic preparations in matrix detoxification and prevention of disease chronicity

The serious health problems of the majority of Russians make the issues of early detection of health disorders and diagnosis of a pre-morbid state one of the important tasks of clinical medicine. The poor public health of the population is associated with the problem of low fertility, high prevalence of socially significant pathology (arterial hypertension, diabetes mellitus, sexually transmitted infections, toxic and drug addiction, etc.). In recent years, the deterioration in reproductive health has been alarming.

The majority of the population still retains a passive attitude towards their health and the belief that care and responsibility for the health of each person is fully entrusted to the state and doctors. Recently, in some regions, a clinical examination of the population has begun, which will allow for preventive measures aimed at protecting the health of the population, although in health care, as before, a sick person remains a priority, while the object of preventive medicine should be a healthy one.

Preventive medicine, the object of which is a healthy person, has its own methodology, research methods. As a scientific direction, it is rooted in traditional medicine and naturopathy. The past century was marked by the convergence of two branches of medicine: academic and traditional, which made it possible to create new technologies for restoring the broken relationships between man and nature. This rapprochement became possible thanks to the contribution of Russian scientists Vernadsky, Dokuchaev, Chizhevsky and many others. This row also includes the names of domestic researchers who have developed and implemented unique technologies for primary prevention, methods of early diagnosis - Gotovsky Yu.V., Kosareva L.B., Makhonkina L.B., Nesterov I.V. and etc.

Recently, numerous health centers and health-improving complexes have appeared, using in their practice the method of vegetative resonance test (ART) in various modifications, exogenous and endogenous bioresonance therapy, etc. The high efficiency of using homeopathic medicines as a regulatory therapy has been proven.

It is promising to use the methods of electropunctural diagnostics to assess the state of the whole organism from the standpoint of preventing various disorders and the development of diseases. Another great scientist S.P. Botkin wrote: "When using various therapeutic methods, do not just think that you are treating the very essence of the disease. The doctor only helps the body to cope with the disease, to cope with its own protective techniques. All this can be done on the basis of the requirement - to take the organism as a whole, at the same time taking into account the influence of the environment on the human body".

Using the ART method in our center, studies were carried out with

the priority definition of integrative indicators: adaptive reserves, psycho-vegetative status, the state of the immune system, endocrine system and biological indices. The latter indicator provides extremely valuable information that allows an integrative assessment of the real threat or the presence of severe degenerative processes.

Biological age is a reflection of the functional state of the mesenchyme, consisting of four components: the main substance with extracellular fluid, connective tissue cells, the functional system of end vessels, and neuro-vegetative terminal plexuses. Cell - Wednesday, according to Pischinger, is in the first place when diseases occur. The theory is based on the idea of the accumulation of toxic factors in the intercellular space at the first stages of the disease - the humoral phases of homotoxicosis - which are the initial, reversible phases of any disease. Based on this, it seems promising both from the point of view of general detoxification of the body and as a stage of therapy to obtain the possibility of a targeted effect on the mesenchyme in order to identify aggravating factors and drainage.

If the system of tissues of the internal environment, which is a mesenchyme, or loose connective tissue, is taken as a single organ, then it can be assessed by standard parameters in what state it is, and the main systemic aggravating factors can be identified. One of the most important links, without which full-fledged work of all organs and cells of the body is impossible, is the matrix.

With the accumulation of toxins, the activity of the connective tissue is disrupted, and less and less nutrients can freely flow to the cells of the body. The most complex complex relationships between the immune, hormonal and nervous systems are destroyed, and the disease develops.

The creator of the scientific theory of homotoxicology, German physician and scientist Hans Heinrich Reckeweg described this process as a deposit phase. In this case, the transfer of various substances through the matrix is disrupted due to the compaction of the space around the cells. A deficiency arises, in which the cells of organs do not receive a sufficient amount of useful substances and oxygen and metabolic products are not removed from them. Antihomotoxic drugs have unique opportunities for body detoxification and regulatory therapy.

We observed 123 patients aged 38 to 62 years, in whom the integrative parameters (adaptation reserves, psycho-vegetative status, the state of the immune and endocrine systems and biological indices) were assessed by the ART method. Of these, 48 people worked under the influence of industrial hazards (underground mine miners), 52 were patients with chronic diseases of the digestive system, 23 - with diseases of the cardiovascular system. The effectiveness of treatment was assessed by the dynamics of biological indices, i.e. to cleanse the matrix.

For complex detoxification and drainage in 86 patients, we used a Detox-complex containing Lymphomyosot, Nux vomica and Berberis compositum. According to the indications, other homeopathic remedies were also prescribed (Mucose compositum, Placenta compositum, Tonsilla compositum and others).

Treatment with complex drugs of modern homeopathy and

homotoxicology in combination with bioresonance therapy has shown its effectiveness. The highest efficiency was achieved in patients with diabetes mellitus - 64% and with chronic pathology of the gastrointestinal tract - 62.8%. In the presence of *Helicobacter pylori* infection, the BRT treatment regimen proposed by the IMEDIS Center was used.

For the implementation of bioresonance therapy, we used the medical devices of the IMEDIS Center and the Institute of Applied Psychophysics.

Thus, using modern methods of express diagnostics of the state of not only the whole organism, but also cellular and subcellular structures based on the phenomena of biological resonance, it is possible to come close to solving the issues of prenosological assessment of health disorders and their correction. The complex use of BRT and complex homeopathic preparations in the treatment and detoxification of the body makes it possible to prevent the chronicization of pathological processes and the development of degenerative changes in tissues.
