

Mumps viruses (case from practice)

Clinical example

Patient F., 38 years old. She turned to the Eliseeva Center with complaints of high blood pressure, palpitations with paroxysmal tachycardia attacks, panic attacks and severe weakness. According to her, she was treated and examined by many specialists for a long time and unsuccessfully.

An ART examination revealed that there is a high degree of tension in the endocrine system in the thyroid gland and adrenal glands. An excess of T3 and T4 hormones, adrenaline, cortisol was tested. Functional deficiency of TSH, ACTH, insulin. Prediabetes 1.

Testing has shown a very high degree of immune system strain associated with viral load. Chronic inflammation of the thyroid, pancreas caused by the PAROTITIS virus. The same virus in potencies D30-D200 was detected in the anterior lobe of the pituitary gland, adrenal glands, ovaries, meninges. The patient recalled that as a teenager, she had a hard time mumps with a high fever for a week. The identified localization of the virus is not surprising, given that the mumps virus is tragic to the interstitial tissue of the glandular organs and the nervous system.

For treatment, resonance frequency therapy, BRT were used (at the first sessions - with the inversion of the virus, and then directly in the tested potencies). Appropriate PBS-preparation, organopreparations of glands, homeopathic remedies were prescribed. After 3 weeks of treatment, the patient began to notice a clear improvement in her general condition. At a certain point, a painful swelling appeared behind the right ear (return of old symptoms, which is what we expect when prescribing homeopathy).

During treatment, the patient was able to stop taking antihypertensive drugs (she took B-blockers and ACE inhibitors), panic attacks stopped, and her general condition returned to normal. In the words of the patient herself: "The invisible enemy has been defeated!"
