A correctly identified cause of the disease is the key to successful therapy.

The goal of the doctor is to help the patient solve the problem he came with. There are several options for identifying the root cause of the disease. All variants assume the identification of a key organ, tested according to any index scale that reflects the organism as a whole. Using the most complete picture of the patient's pathology, it is possible through it to find drugs that can cure the patient's body as a whole, that is, we find the key problem, then select the therapy for this problem.

BRT was performed, a general BR-preparation, preparations BR1, BR2 were made, homeopathic preparations were selected. The stool returned to normal after 3 days, the abdominal pains disappeared. Examination in a month no complaints of the gastrointestinal tract.
- 2. Patient, a 5-year-old girl, diagnosed with Thrombocytopenic Purpura. Sick for more than 6 months. The disease began with a temperature of 38 ° C for 4 days. After hitting the wheelchair, a hematoma formed. In the analysis of blood platelets 10 thousand, eos. 25%. Was treated by a hematologist. Every 2 weeks a blood test was taken, platelets did not rise above 90-100 thousand. Contact us at the Center. The testing revealed a disturbed meridian of blood circulation and spleen, the most affected organ is the spleen. Acquired toxic information parasites. Hematobium schistosoma was found in the blood and spleen. BR-preparations have been made, homeopathy has been prescribed. After 2 weeks of treatment: platelets 124 thousand, eos. 10%. In a month, platelets 250 thousand, eos. 7%. After 2 months: platelets 250 thousand, eos. 6%. The girl underwent BRT treatment once a month for 6 months.

Conclusions: using the ART method, you can determine the organ of the lesion and the causes diseases, find drugs that can cure the body.

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
