

Chakras from the ART perspective

The use of the vegetative resonance test (ART) [1] to determine the biophysical state of the chakras allows the doctor to find not only the shortest path to the patient's health problems, but also to reveal potentially hidden problems that are inaccessible for research by other methods.

Chakra theory is one of the most convenient models for working with both physical and mental, emotional, and sometimes parapsychological problems. This aspect is extremely important for the treatment of complex patients, when it is necessary to isolate the main complex of problems, or the "core" of pathology, which may lie above the level at which modern medicine operates [2].

I successfully use for diagnostics and therapy preparations of the chakras of the firms "OTI", "Rostock", presented in the medicament selector of the equipment of the center "IMEDIS". Using these preparations, it was possible to establish resonant relationships between the chakras and the primary elements of the periodic system of D.I. Mendeleev (Table 1).

Each horizontal row of elements of the table. 1 resonates with the chakras from 7 to 1 and, in fact, is a fragment of certain periods of the D.I. Mendeleev. Elements of the central column in table. 1 are, apparently, the nuclei of the chakras and are represented in the selector as "metals for testing chakras".

From table. 1 shows that the chakras have common elements located in different sequences. So, for example, chakras 7 and 4 have 80% of common elements, which indicates their close relationship, manifested in clinical symptoms and diseases of organs. Based on the commonality of the chakra elements, the unifying symptoms "7-4", "5-2", "3-1" can be distinguished. So, for example, in acute psychoemotional disorder (chakra 7), myocardial infarction may occur (chakra 4), if the heart rhythm is disturbed (chakra 4), an ischemic stroke (chakra 7) may occur, chronic tonsillitis and rashes on the face (chakra 5) are often combined with problems in gynecology (chakra 2), varicose veins of the lower extremities (chakra 1) are often combined with portal hypertension (chakra 3), etc.

And only only chakra 6 has a special status and a set of elements that is not repeated with other chakras, which speaks of its functional importance for a person. It is not for nothing that Ajna is considered the center of wisdom and intuition, controls the functions of the right hemisphere, autonomic nervous and endocrine systems [2].

Using the chakra preparations recorded in the selector as filters, it is possible to diagnose the body quickly and accurately using the ART method. And homeopathic remedies of the elements presented in table. 1, selected in appropriate potencies in conjunction with endogenous bioresonance therapy (BRT) [3], are able to solve the most intricate health problems at both the physical and psychoemotional levels.
