

Possible approach to the rehabilitation of reproductive organs and
an integrated approach to the treatment of complex infertility

The medical community knows the trend of our time - a decrease in the reproductive function of women and men. Different figures are declared (according to a number of authors, from 10 to 34%), but in general, every third woman of reproductive age has problems with conception or miscarriage. The concept of Russia's demographic policy for the period up to 2025, approved by the Decree of the President of the Russian Federation on October 9, 2007 No. 1351, touches upon the problems solved by restorative medicine.

Teida Clinic staff often face the problem of infertility. This article presents an analysis of our 2-year work in this direction and its results.

There were 38 women and 7 married couples under our supervision. The patients' age is from 18 to 48 years. Of these, 45 are women and 7 are men. Most of the patients had a long reproductive history, had previously been examined, women - in gynecological departments, and men - at andrologists and reproductive specialists, 56% of patients had experience of unsuccessful IVF (once or repeatedly).

The principles of diagnostics were as follows: study by the method of autonomic resonance test (ART) of the endocrine, immune, autonomic systems, testing of nosodes of diseases of the reproductive sphere, infectious nosodes, hereditary factors, the state of the meridians (according to traditional Chinese medicine).

The treatment was comprehensive:

- bioresonance therapy - course sessions;
- methods of traditional Chinese medicine;
- the use of a cellular matrix in the form of a "Metabolite".

All patients were divided into 4 groups. The first group included patients who underwent BRT and oriental medicine courses according to individually selected schemes.

The second group additionally underwent a course of study of serum for antiembryonic antigen in men in the high-tech hospital "Antai" (Beijing, China), which has an individual patent.

The third group, against the background of bioresonance therapy, received metabolite therapy (treatment with natural and obligatory irreplaceable components of normal cell activity, which easily changes the pathologically disturbed cell biosis into the usual and natural channel of evolutionarily fixed metabolic reactions - the work of V.I. Vernadsky, V.E. Rodoman) ...

All three groups also received courses of treatment for those underlying diseases that directly affect the state of reproductive health.

The duration of the combined courses of treatment and rehabilitation measures varied from 1 month to 1.5 years.

In 100% of cases, there was a powerful stress factor - a "silent killer", one of the mechanisms of which is an increase in the tone of the sympathoadrenal system. This, on the one hand, contributes to the activation of psychophysical resources, and, on the other hand, is the most important factor in the pathogenesis of damage to the cardiovascular system as a whole, leading to depressive states of tissues (which we note in electropuncture diagnostics), and how, as a result, to a change blood supply to the small pelvis and, in particular, to the reproductive organs, causing hypoxic conditions. Proceeding from this, the use of metabolite therapy in the form of the drug "Metabolite-Life" was logically justified. Metabolic therapy promotes an increase in the activity of the lysosomal structure of monocytes and neutrophils, an increase in the synthesis of protein, RNA, DNA, an increase in the level of specific receptors on the membrane of T- and B-lymphocytes, etc. It is a biosubstrate that regulates metabolism and delivers electrons to the area of affected cellular structures.

Having carried out these therapeutic measures to patients, we received the following joyful results: 21 out of 38 women became pregnant, 14 of them have already had children, 7 pregnant women are observed by our specialists and at the same time - at the place of residence. In 5 married couples, an anti-embryonic antigen was detected, which made the onset of pregnancy almost impossible. They were prescribed a personal vaccine from a man's blood serum, they are being treated and monitored. Two married couples are already expecting a baby after the end of the course of taking the vaccine.

Based on the above, the following conclusions can be drawn:

1. One of the pressing problems of modern reproduction is development of an algorithm for medical and rehabilitation measures in women and men with the obligatory use of electropuncture diagnostics and bioresonance therapy. This significantly increases the likelihood of pregnancy in a natural way and allows you to bring it to a safe end.

2. Inclusion of metabolic therapy technologies in the complex of medical measures significantly increases the effectiveness of treatment of concomitant pathology in persons of reproductive age. Metabolic-type drugs, in particular "Metabolite-Life 3+", which we selected using the ART method, are an important reserve for providing energy to patients of reproductive age in order to maximize the possibility of conception.

Thus, combined therapy based on bioresonance therapy increases the effectiveness of traditional approaches to the treatment of reproductive organs in the childbearing contingent. All this serves as the basis for further study of the effectiveness of this method and a combination of natural, natural, ethical methods of restorative medicine in relation to the body.
