

## The use of bioresonance therapy in the treatment of alcohol addiction

Today in our society there is such a problem as alcoholism, and it is quite relevant. It is worth noting that alcoholism has become much younger. The worst thing is teenage alcoholism, because in adolescent children, the psyche is poorly formed, which is associated, first of all, with the transition period. People in their 20s and older tend to suffer from beer alcoholism, creating an environment for fungi in the body. As a rule, there are such reasons for drunkenness: commemoration, holidays, meeting, seeing off, christening, weddings and divorce, frost, hunting, New Year, recovery, housewarming, sadness, remorse, fun, success, reward, a new position and just for no reason ...

Alcoholism is a serious chronic disease, in most cases difficult to cure. It is also a type of substance abuse, characterized by an addiction to alcohol with mental and physical dependence on it. Alcoholism is characterized by a loss of control over the amount of alcohol consumed, an increase in alcohol tolerance.

Alcoholism is formed imperceptibly for the person himself, therefore, for a long time he considers himself "healthy", that he "drinks like everyone else", and that "if he wants, he will easily quit drinking". But it turns out to be not so easy.

Alcohol dependence is of 3 stages: Stage 1 - mental dependence;  
Stage 2 - physical and chemical;  
Stage 3 - alcohol degradation.

It should be noted that most of the crimes are committed on domestic grounds in a state of alcoholic intoxication, every third road traffic accident is committed by people in a state of intoxication, half of suicides are due to alcoholic intoxication. This once again proves and confirms that this problem is very urgent and significant, and it should be addressed. Today, methods exist and are being applied to solve this problem, but as the results show, they only relieve symptoms, and in most cases are ineffective.

In our center "MEDAX" we approached the solution of this problem from the other side, looking at it, first of all, as a psychological one, and found the most correct and effective solution to this issue with the help of bioresonance therapy on equipment produced by the Center for Intelligent Medical Systems "IMEDIS ".

### Clinical example

A 30-year-old patient turned to our MEDAX center with a desire to finally get rid of alcohol addiction and reconsider his attitude to life.

### Diagnostics

As a result of testing with the vegetative resonance test

have established the cause of the addiction - it is a mental load that has ever been transferred or a shock burden. Mental stress is tested in most cases. As a rule, it is the main cause of alcoholism. The affected organ was the liver. A change in metabolic processes, a violation of the hormonal background, and a toxic load were revealed.

The treatment was carried out using the IMEDIS equipment: the IMEDIS-ESPERT hardware-software complex, the MINI-EXPERT-T therapeutic apparatus, devices for magnetic therapy. To eliminate mental burden, a course of preparations Bach Flowers, induction programs of brain rhythms, frequency programs for detoxification of the body and elimination of toxic load were selected.

The entire course of treatment lasted two weeks and consisted of induction programs with brain rhythms, detoxification programs, and the use of a private bioresonance drug.

#### Result

The result of the treatment was not long in coming and appeared within the first three days. The patient lost his desire to drink, developed an aversion to alcohol, the patient changed his attitude towards life, and other interests appeared.

#### Output

This technique shows that it is a more effective method of treating alcohol dependence, is available and can be used as the main method of treatment, as well as in complex treatment with other methods both in a hospital setting and on an outpatient basis. The method of bioresonance therapy allows achieving an effective result and shortening the treatment time for patients with alcohol dependence.
