Within the framework of the conference, 3 master classes were held: "Theory and practice of Chinese acupuncture" (Professor N.A. Nikolaev), "Pelvic instability. Indications and contraindications for manual therapy "(Professor Vasilyeva L.F.), "Disclosure of the body's internal reserves with the help of training stress, using Lyapko's application suit and Lyapko's therapeutic breathing techniques" (PhD Lyapko N.G.), read one lecture "Why do we need Chinese medicine? (Professor Nikolaev N.A.). During the conference there was an exhibition of literature on reflexology, manual therapy, devices and instruments used for the diagnosis and treatment of patients of various profiles was organized.

Based on the results of the conference, a resolution was adopted with proposals for improving the work of state services of reflexology and manual therapy in Russia.

The conference was attended by 215 specialists, including: 4 academicians, 13 professors, 17 doctors of medical sciences, 5 associate professors, 23 candidates of medical sciences, 146 doctors, 1 senior researcher, 15 specialists of various specialties from Belarus, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Romania, Ukraine and from 27 regions of the Russian Federation.

The conference participants expressed their gratitude to the Minister of Health of Russia V.I. Skvortsova and the chief neurologist of the Ministry of Health of Russia E.I. Gusev for issuing order No. 707-n dated 08.10. 2015 On approval of the Qualification requirements for medical and pharmaceutical workers with higher education in the direction of training "Health and medical sciences", expanding the possibilities of teaching doctors the methods of reflexology and manual therapy.

The participants of the conference expressed their gratitude to the rector of GBOU FVE RMAPE Academician L.K. Moshetova for business support in holding the conference.

After listening to and discussing the reports of the main experts, leading scientists, reflexologists and manual therapists, the conference participants expressed a consolidated agreement that:

- professional activity of reflexologists and chiropractors therapists is carried out in accordance with the current legislation of the Russian Federation and has a fairly complete regulatory framework;
- in modern conditions, reflexology and manual therapy (as a form of professional activity) is a necessary part of the health care system and contributes to improving the efficiency of diagnostic, therapeutic, expert, and preventive measures.

Conference attendees expressed concern that:

schedule of state healthcare institutions of the Russian Federation;

– in connection with the closure of the Central Research Institute reflexology there is no head institution that coordinates the scientific, organizational, methodological and medical work of reflexology and manual therapy services in the Russian Federation;

Based on the results of the conference, its participants made the following decisions:

- 1. Ask the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation for expanding the network of rooms and departments of reflexology and manual therapy in the public health system due to the high efficiency and cost-effectiveness of methods, the growing need of the population for these types of qualified medical care.
- 2. Assign the duties of the head institution to one of the departments: neurology or reflexology, manual therapy.
- 3. Due to the fact that both specialties are classified as specialties, requiring additional training, as well as in connection with the renaming of departments and courses, apply for the transfer of the specialties "Reflexology" and "Manual Therapy" to the category of basic specialties.
- 4. Apply for the organization of a section of reflexology and manual therapy at the All-Russian Society of Neurologists.
- 5. Restore the attestation commission for reflexology and manual therapy at the Central Attestation Commission of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation.
- 6. Expand opportunities for international cooperation with leading scientific centers for scientific, educational, methodological and practical work.
- 7. To enhance the role of reflexology and manual therapy methods in national healthcare in the Russian branch of the Cochrane Collaboration, it is advisable to create a working group to unify terminology and develop standards for research conducted on them in the format of evidence-based medicine.
- 8. Apply for holding scientific and practical conferences with international participation or congresses on reflexology and manual therapy on a regular basis every 5–10 years on the basis of the Russian Medical Academy of Postgraduate Education.
